

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON PLAN COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, April 19, 2011**  
**7:30 p.m.**

The Chairman, Mike Raabe, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Farmington Town Hall. Other members present were Paul Lash, Joan Dolbier and Roxie Storandt. Steve Kirchner was absent.

Roxie read the minutes from the March 15, 2011 meeting. Joan made a motion to approve the minutes, and Paul seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Amanda Christianson then addressed the Plan Commission. She would like a conditional use permit to expand her in-home child daycare (Great Outdoor Learning Center) to a group licensed daycare. They would be open from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday. This daycare would be in the basement of her home. She will have one employee. She presented a very detailed business plan to the Plan Commission. She has already met with a commercial building inspector.

Roxie made a motion that the Plan Commission recommend to the Town of Farmington Town Board approval of a conditional use permit for Amanda Christianson at W5602 County Highway D to expand her in-home child daycare to a group licensed child daycare. This meets the Economic Development Element of the Town of Farmington Comprehensive Plan. In supporting Goals A & B under this element, she can provide child care closer to the town's agricultural and other existing businesses. As she plans to remain in her home with less than five employees, she meets Goal C. She also aligns with Goal A, as she is not expanding any further than her home. Joan seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Roxie made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Paul seconded the motion. The motion passed, and the meeting was adjourned.
