<b>Joshua Waldon</b> <b>Crossfire Inc.</b> <b>LAND REZONE REQUEST</b>  A request to rezone a donated parcel of land located on AE from Ag to Single Family Residential.	Presenting on behalf of Crossfire Inc. was Joshua Waldon. He explained the history of how the non-profit group acquired the land through a donation from HF Eagle Properties LLC and the reasoning behind the request to rezone parcel (parcel 5-178-1) from Agriculture to Single Family Residential. The group discussed the fact that the parcel is over 10 acres under the 35 acre requirement to build a house, the history of the surrounding parcels and the access road that appears to fall on the parcel in question. The committee did not feel that they had enough information to make a decision and wish to table the request until the June 2015 meeting.  <b>Mmsp: Mike / Steve</b> "I make a motion that the request be tabled until June 2015 to allow for more information regarding the history of the parcel and access road to be obtained."  <b>Action:</b> <i>The committee will meet to discuss further information at the June 16, 2015 Plan Commission Meeting.</i>
