

TOWN OF FARMINGTON PLAN COMMISSION MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
September 29, 2011

Mike Raabe called the meeting to order. All members were present.

Monte McIntyre representing Swiss Valley Farms Cooperative was present requesting a variance of approximately 3 to 4 feet in order to add a 2000 square foot addition for laboratory, conference room, and offices. From the center of roadway the new addition will be back approximately 76 feet.

Steve Kirchner made a motion we recommend to the Town Board approval of a variance for Swiss Valley Farms Cooperative. Joan seconded the motion. Motion passed.

This meets several goals of the Town of Farmington Comprehensive Plan including the Land Use Element Goal B – Encourage organized/planned development of nonagricultural uses including commercial throughout the Town of Farmington, Goal C – Guide commercial, industrial to the unincorporated community of Mindoro where public sewer and water services are available and also the Economic Development Element Goal A – Sustain existing agricultural businesses in the Town of Farmington, Goal B – Encourage and assist existing businesses to grow and Goal D – focus industrial, commercial, and retail businesses in the unincorporated community of Mindoro.
