

# Town of Farmington – 2016 Taxes

## TAX INFORMATION

Your tax bill(s) has a bottom portion that needs to be returned with your payment. Checks should be made out to the Town of Farmington. The charge for a NSF check is \$20.00. Please read the back of your tax bill as it contains important information regarding your tax bill and failure to pay timely.

You may drop your payment in the drop box located by the front door of the Farmington Town Hall door. The drop box will be checked daily at 5:00 p.m. between December 21, 2016 and January 31, 2017.

Payments postmarked by December 31, 2016 will be considered being paid in 2016.

All mailed in payments must be postmarked by January 31, 2017.

**Please enclose a large self-addressed stamped envelope if you want a receipt for your mailed in or drop box tax payment.**

You may bring your tax payment in person to the **Farmington Town Hall** on the following dates:

## DOG LICENSES

Wisconsin Statutes require that all dogs over the age of 5 months be licensed. The licenses can be purchased from the Treasurer when paying your taxes. Documentation of rabies vaccination is required for new dogs and for license renewals if the previous vaccination expiration has passed. Renewals after April 1, 2017 must be purchased at La Crosse County Clerk's office. Licenses for new dogs still may be purchased from the Town of Farmington treasurer. **If you no longer have a dog, please tell me so records can be updated at the county clerk's office.**

Dog license fees are the following:

Non-Spayed/Non Neutered dogs - \$21.00  
Spayed/Neutered dogs - \$11.00  
Multiple dogs - \$80.00
