

Public Hearing of the Proposed Budget and Special meeting - December 4, 2018

Public Hearing – 2019 Proposed Budget

The Public Hearing of the Proposed Budget was called to order at 7:30 pm. Budget was read and reviewed by all present. Chairman Hesse explained that the Sanitary District had implemented a water rate increase to residents as well as a \$15,000 hydrant rental increase to the township. Additionally, the township will undergo a re-valuation of property over the next two years at a total cost of \$50,000. There were no questions. Hearing was closed at 7:40pm.

Special Town Meeting of Electors

The Special Town Meeting was called to order at 7:40pm following the Budget Hearing. Chairman Hesse read the resolution to exceed the levy limit by \$25,000 needed to pay the increase in hydrant rental and the re-valuation of the property. Motion to approve the resolution made by Dennis Konze, seconded by Dan Heidel. Vote by raise of hands: 7 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain. Motion passed.

Motion made by Dan Heidel to approve the levy limit of \$441,995.00, seconded by Dennis Konze. Motion passed. Levy limit adopted.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:50 by Konze, seconded by Heidel.
