

Town of Farmington—2020 Taxes

Treasurer's Tax Collection

Your tax bill(s) has a bottom portion that needs to be returned with your payment. Please read the back of your tax bill as it contains important information regarding your tax bill and failure to pay timely. Listed below are different options to pay your tax bill. **DUE TO COVID, IT IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENT BY MAIL OR DROP BOX.**

1. Mail in your tax payment to the following address:

2. Drop your payment in the drop box located by the front door of the Farmington Town Hall door. The drop box will be checked daily between December 15, 2020 and January 31, 2021.
3. Pay with your credit or debit card. **This service will charge the cardholder a 3% transaction fee.** This type of payment can be made on-line at www.townoffarmingtonlax.org. **I am unable to take payments over the phone.**
4. You may bring your tax payment in person to the **Farmington Town Hall** on the following dates but **due to COVID, I will not be giving receipts on these days. You will be able to drop your payment off in person and if you wish a receipt will be mailed to you.**

Wednesday, December 30, 2020 – 10:00 a.m.—7:00 p.m.
Saturday, January 30, 2021—10:00 a.m.—7:00 p.m.

Please enclose a large self-addressed stamped envelope if you want a receipt.

Your entire real estate tax bill, or your first installment, is **due by January 31, 2021**. If you choose to pay in installments, your first installment is due by January 31, 2021 and your second installment is due by July 31, 2021. Make note that the amount of your installments may vary. If you fail to pay the correct amount, at the correct time, to the correct place it will cause you to incur additional charges. Any taxes paid after January 31, 2021 are payable to:

2021 Dog Licenses

All dogs in the Town of Farmington must be vaccinated against rabies and must be licensed by 5 months of age.

A dog license can be purchased between now and April 1st to avoid a late fee and citation. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required to license your dog. The fee to license your dog is \$12.00 for an altered dog and \$23.00 for an unaltered dog.

If you fail to license your dog by April 1st, you must purchase a dog license from the County Clerk's office and pay a late fee of \$25.00 plus the cost of the dog license. This also applies if you get a new dog and fail to license it, if your puppy turns 5 months old and you fail to license it, or if you move into the township and fail to license it within 30 days.

If you previously owned a dog, your dog license information is included in with your tax bill. Please look over to see if you need to provide updated rabies information before you are able to renew your licenses.
