PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Mike Hesse, called the Public Budget Hearing to order at 7:00pm.

Mike walked those in attendance through the levy limit and budget.

Mike explained that there was a change made to the posted budgets and that levy limit with approval of the electors would be increased by \$15,952. These extra funds are due to the transfer of Mindoro Park ownership in 2021. \$15,952 of 2021 LaCrosse County levy limit originally earmarked for the Mindoro Park is not being deducted from the 2022 LaCrosse County Levy limit and added to the levy limit for the Town of Farmington.

Mike reported that the final allowable levy limit for 2022 payable in 2023 is \$524,869.

It was noted that ARPA funds have now been earmarked. \$70,000 will be used to line the sewer pipes from the school to Prairie Farms. The remaining funds will be used towards highway maintenance projects.

No objections were made. Mike Hesse closed the hearing at 7:10pm.

SPECIAL MEETING OF ELECTORS CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Mike Hesse, called the Special Meeting of Electors to order at 7:10pm.

Town Board asked for the electors to approve the 2022 Levy payable in 2023 at the allowable amount of \$524,869.
