## **Call To Order**

## **JAYDEN BARNEY | County Road VV**

Jayden Barney was in attendance to discuss the 1999 Multiple Housing Road Specs Ordinance and how it pertains to his plans to build a house onto parcel 5-803-2. He is requesting a variance from the ordinance be granted to relieve him from understood obligation of having to pave a 20' wide surface.

Discussion took place regarding the requirements listed within the ordinance, with commission members acknowledging the ambiguous nature of some of its contents.

No recommendation was formed in regard to Barney's request. The commission decided to table the topic until they have had time to further review and update the ordinance in a way that will more clearly outline the requirements for shared driveways.

- **1999 Multiple Housing Road Specs Ordinance**

No decisions were made. Discussion took place regarding the requirements listed within the ordinance, with the commission acknowledging the ambiguous nature of some of its contents.

- **Consider Resolution 2026-2 – Make Decision**

Town Board quorum was not met, therefore, this item was not discussed or decided upon. Resolution 2026-2, to show support for a comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution for Wisconsin, will be placed onto the April 2026 town meeting agenda.

- **Public Concern**

Dennis Jacobsen, County Board Supervisor, was in attendance to share updates on future road construction plans for the Town of Farmington. A section of County Road T and Q are tentatively scheduled to be reconstructed in 2027. He is actively seeking support to replace the bridge on County Road A. He also acknowledged, though, that even if funding was awarded this year, repairs would not be completed for approximately another two years.
